The Second Vatican Council reminded
us that the **Eucharist** is 'the source and
summit of the Christian life' (Lumen
Gentium 11), while Augustine, in a
homily on the Eucharist advised "It is
your own mystery that you are receiving!
You are saying "Amen" to what you are
..." This presentation will seek to
explain something of the mystery of this
gift of the Eucharist, of what it means for
a baptised person to participate in the
Eucharist, and also the impact of what it
means to say that the Church makes the
Eucharist while at once the Eucharist
makes the Church. The presentation
aims to be both instructive and
challenging and to go some way toward
addressing the many questions put to
me over the years about this mystery we

Bishop Denis Nulty Announces New Lay Pastoral Minister Training Programme in Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin

The Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin, under the leadership of Bishop Denis Nulty, is inviting people with the courage to step forward and answer an important call to service. A new training programme has been developed to equip laypeople with the essential skills they need to serve as Lay Pastoral Ministers within parishes and pastoral areas. The Lay Pastoral Ministers (Diploma in Pastoral Ministry, Level 7) programme aims to nurture and develop the talents of lay leaders, preparing them to undertake significant roles within their parishes and pastoral areas. "The role of laypeople in our Church is crucial to ensure we invigorate faith in our communities. This is an exciting and important opportunity for people who want to explore their faith on a deeper level and be part of the future of our Church." Members of the public are being invited to a series of information meetings across the diocese to find out more about the Diploma in Pastoral Ministry, Level 7. These meetings will offer an opportunity to anybody who is curious to learn more about the course, its objectives, and the benefits it offers to participants and their communities.
